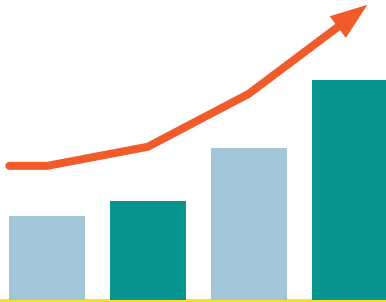


2050 ZERO CARBON CITIES IN JAPAN



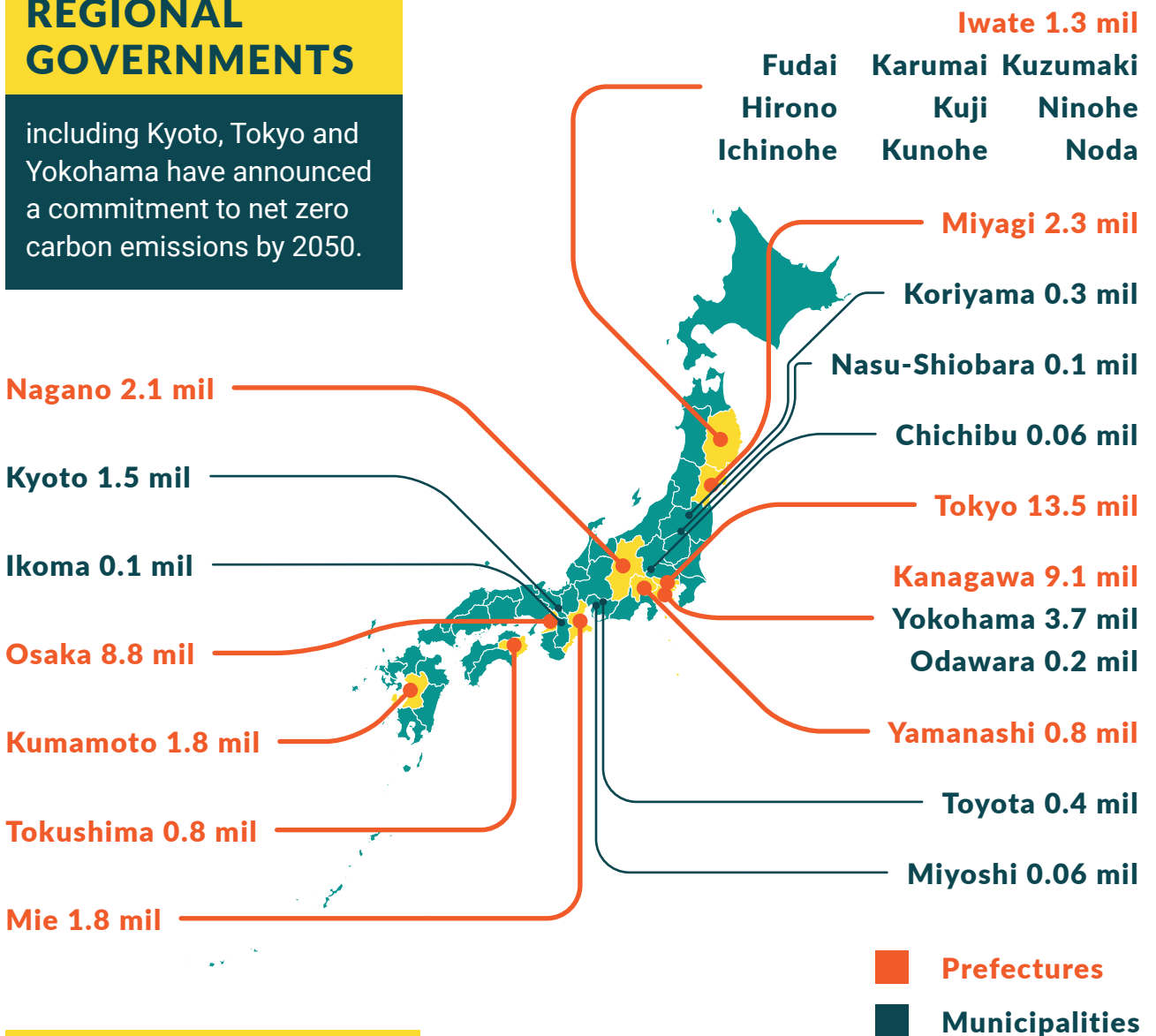

45 MILLION PEOPLE

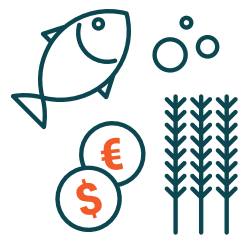
The total population of these local and regional governments represent 35% of Japan's population.
