Information on the Data Owner Application Right

I. Data Owner's Right to Apply

- **Scope of the Right to Apply**

In accordance with Article 11 of the Personal Data Protection Law No.6698 ("KVK Law"), you, as data owners, have the right to request the following issues by applying to us:

- (1) Knowing whether your personal data is processed,
- (2) If your personal data has been processed, to request information regarding this,
- (3) Knowing the purpose of processing your personal data and whether they are used appropriately for their purpose,
- (4) Knowing the third parties to whom your personal data has been transferred domestically or abroad,
- (5) To request correction of your personal data if it is incomplete or incorrectly processed, and to request notification of the transaction made within this scope to third parties to whom your personal data is transferred,
- (6) To request deletion, destruction or anonymization of your personal data in the event that the reasons requiring its processing disappear, despite the fact that personal data has been processed in accordance with the provisions of the protection law and other relevant laws, and to notify the third parties to whom your personal data has been transferred,
- (7) Object to the occurrence of a result against you by analyzing the processed data exclusively through automated systems,
- (8) In case you suffer damage due to unlawful processing of your personal data, requesting the compensation of the damage.

- **Situations Outside the Scope of the Right to Apply**

In accordance with Article 28 of the Personal Data Protection Law, it is not possible for personal data owners to assert their rights in the following matters, since the following situations are not covered by the Law on the protection of personal data:

- (1) Processing of personal data for artistic, historical, literary or scientific purposes or within the scope of freedom of expression, provided that it does not violate national defense, national security, public security, public order, economic security, privacy or personal rights or constitute a crime.
- (2) Processing personal data for purposes such as research, planning and statistics by making them anonymous with official statistics.
- (3) Processing of personal data within the scope of preventive, protective and intelligence activities carried out by public institutions and organizations authorized by law to ensure national defense, national security, public security, public order or economic security.

- (4) Processing of personal data by judicial authorities or execution authorities in relation to investigation, prosecution, trial or execution proceedings.

Pursuant to Article 28/2 of the Personal Data Protection Law; It is not possible for personal data owners to assert their rights, except for demanding compensation in the cases listed below:

- (1) Processing of personal data is necessary for the prevention of crime or for a criminal investigation.
- (2) Processing personal data made public by the personal data owner himself.
- (3) Processing of personal data is necessary for the execution of supervision or regulation duties and disciplinary investigation or prosecution by authorized public institutions and organizations and professional organizations that have the status of public institutions, based on the authority granted by the law.
- (4) Processing of personal data is necessary for the protection of the economic and financial interests of the State regarding budget, tax and financial issues.

II. Finalization of Applications

in accordance with Article 13 of the Personal Data Protection Law, if the personal data owners submit their requests regarding their personal data to us in writing (with wet signature or e-signature instead of wet signature) or by other methods determined by the Personal Data Protection Board, the request will be finalized by us as a data controller as soon as possible and within thirty (30) days at the latest according to the nature of the request.

In order to ensure the security of the data, we may request information from the applicant in order to determine whether the applicant is the owner of the personal data subject to the application. In addition, in order to ensure that the application of the personal data owner is concluded in accordance with the request, a question may be directed to the personal data owner regarding his/her application.

Application of the data owner; In cases such as the possibility of obstructing the rights and freedoms of other people, requiring disproportionate effort, and the information being public information, we may decline the request by explaining the reason.
