## 1 Intention of the document

This document describes the installation of TecLocal 4.0 under Microsoft Windows OS.

## 2 Installation Prerequisites

These are the requisites that need to be met for successfully install TecLocal 4.0.012

## 3 General requisites for TecLocal 4.0 Installation

In order to successfully install and use TecLocal 4.0 Microsoft .NET Framework 4.0 or above has to be installed on the target machine.

### 3.1 Operating System Support

TecLocal 4.0 can be installed and used in the following Operating Systems:

- Server Operating System: Windows Server 2008 R2  
Windows Server 2012 R2  
Windows Server 2016
- Client Operating System: Windows 7  
Windows 8.1  
Windows 10

### 3.2 Requisites for operation mode/installation type

TecLocal 4.0 can be installed in two operations modes. The operation modes are the following:

- Buyer
- Supplier

The Buyer mode can be installed for:

- Single user
- Multiple user

#### 3.2.1 Requisites for operation mode Buyer for a single user

There are no additional requisites for this operation mode/installation type.

#### 3.2.2 Requisites for operation mode Buyer for a multiple user

For this installation scenario a connection with administrator credentials to Microsoft SQL Server instance is required.

#### 3.2.3 Requisites for operation mode Supplier

There are no additional requisites for this operation mode/installation type.

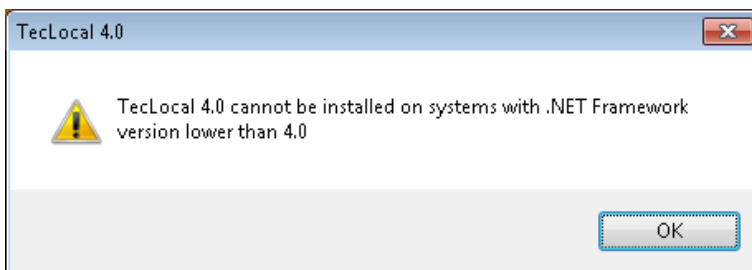


## 4 New installation of TecLocal 4.0.012 as Supplier

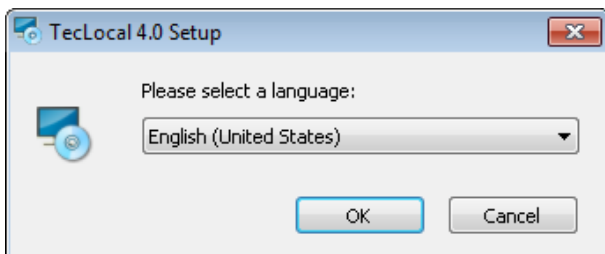
### 4.1 Oracle Database

Download the latest TecLocal installer (TecLocal\_Setup\_V\_4.x.xxx.exe). Start the installation and follow the installation steps.

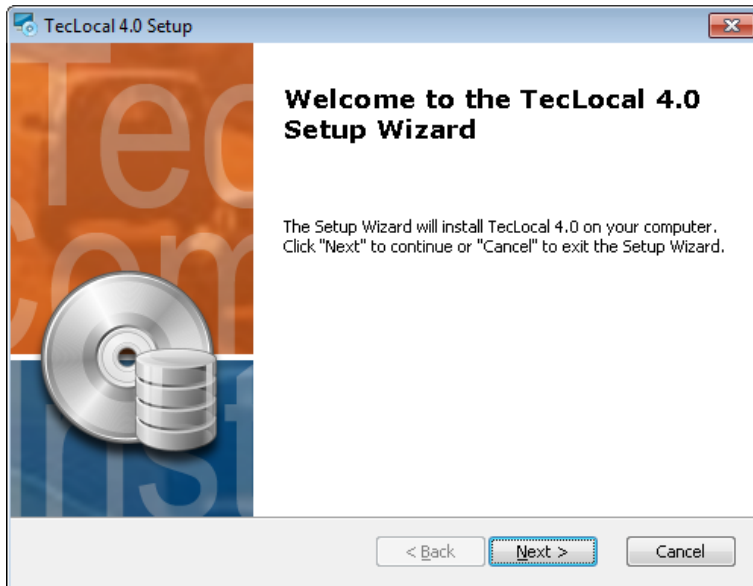
If Microsoft .NET Framework 4.0 or above was not installed in the target machine the following message is shown after the installation language is selected:



Install Microsoft .NET Framework 4.0 or above and then start the installation again.



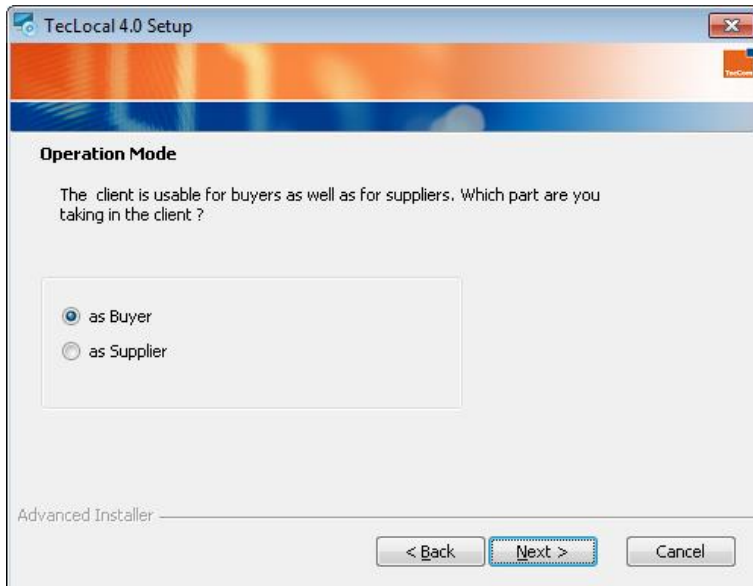
Select the language for the installation wizard and click "OK"



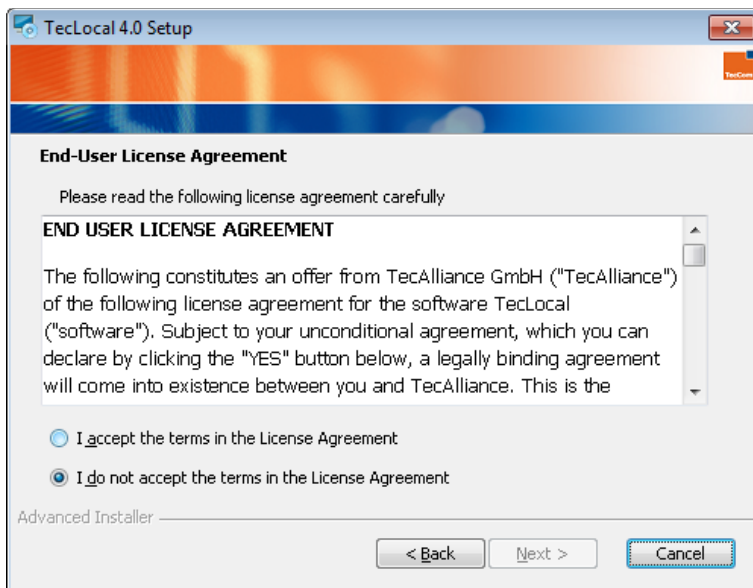

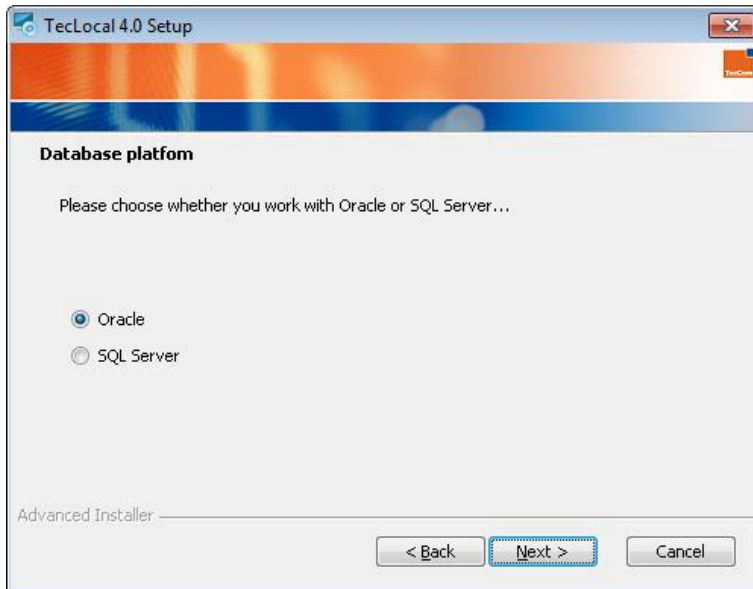
Select the installation folder and click "Next"



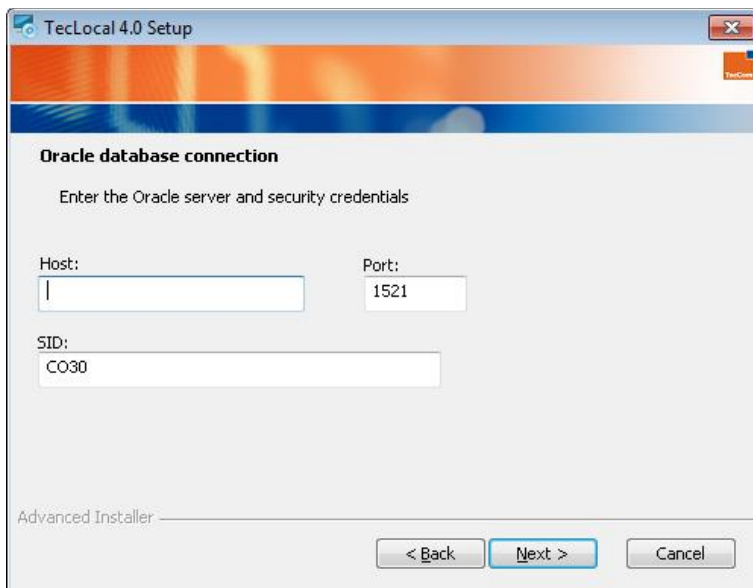
Select *"as Supplier"* and click *"Next"*

Select "Oracle" and click "Next"

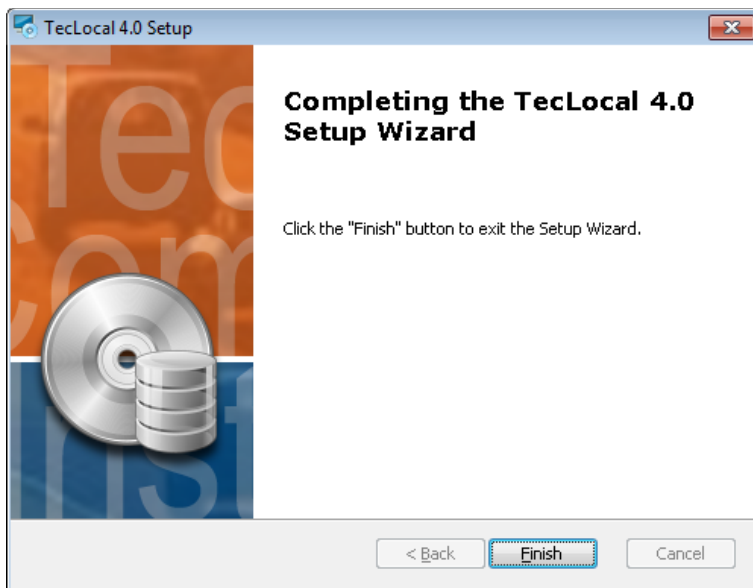


Type the IP of the host where the Oracle database is located, the port used and the SID of the database, then click "Next".





Click *"Install"*



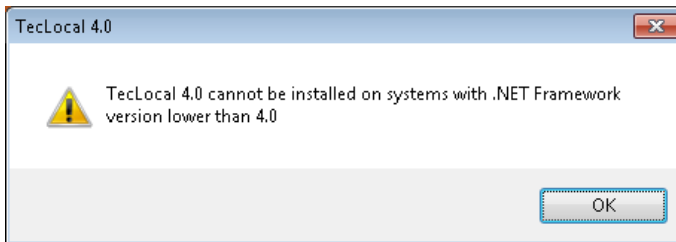

## 4.2 Microsoft SQL Server Database

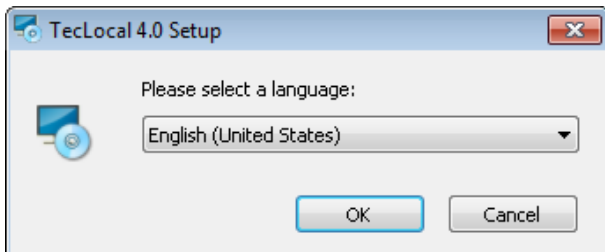
Download the latest TecLocal 4.0.012 installer. Launch the installer and follow the installation steps.



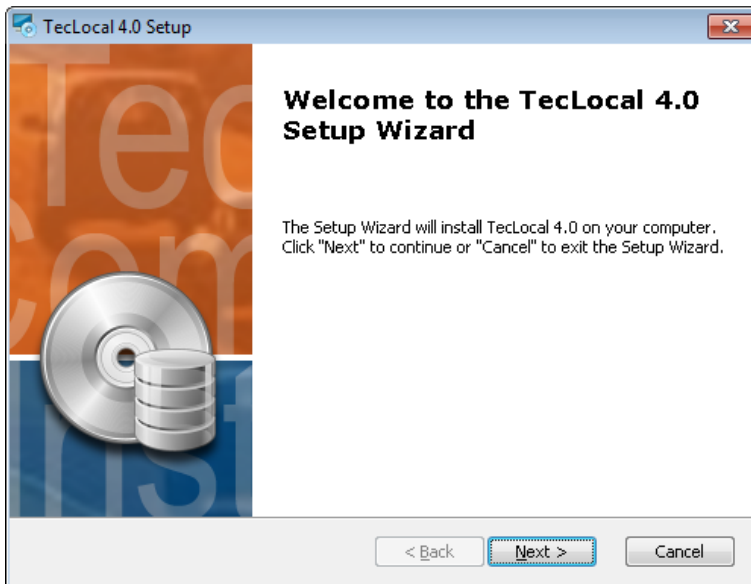
If Microsoft .NET Framework 4.0 or above was not installed in the target machine the following message is shown:

TecLocal Buyer mode has to installation types:

- Single User installation



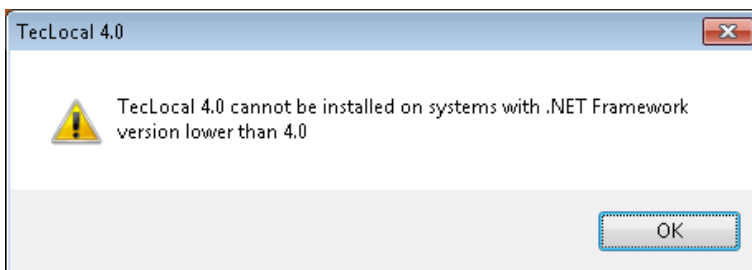
- Multi-User installation

Single user installation will use Microsoft Access database for storing data. Multi-user installation requires a Microsoft SQL Server database

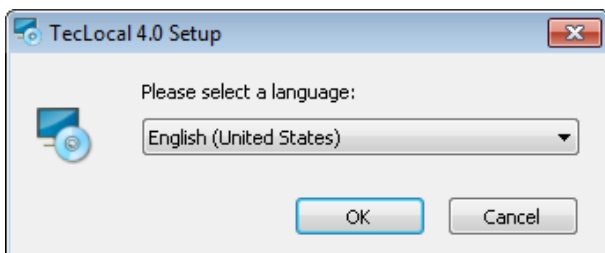
## 5.1 Single User Installation

Download the latest TecLocal installer (TecLocal\_Setup\_V\_4.x.xxx.exe). Start the installation and follow the installation steps.

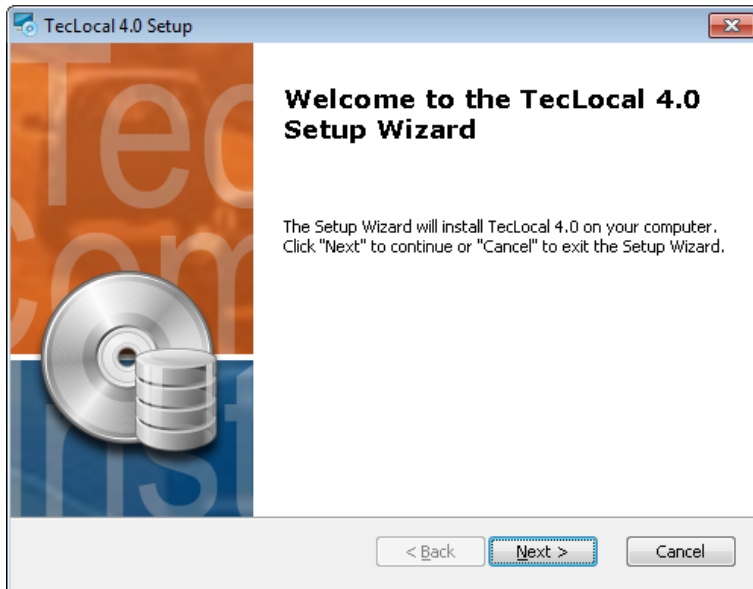
If Microsoft .NET Framework 4.0 or above was not installed in the target machine the following message is shown after the installation language is selected:

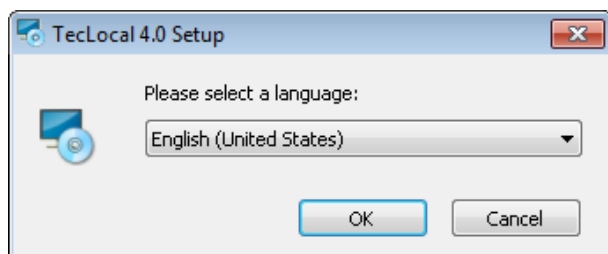
## 5.2 Multi-User Installation

Download the latest TecLocal installer (TecLocal\_Setup\_V\_4.x.xxx.exe). Start the installation and follow the installation steps.

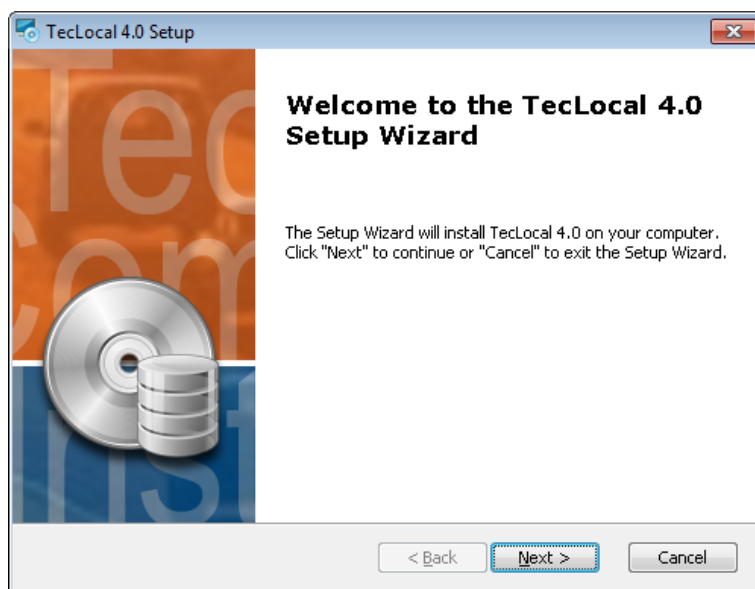
If Microsoft .NET Framework 4.0 or above was not installed in the target machine the following message is shown after the installation language is selected:

Select the language for the installation wizard and click "OK"



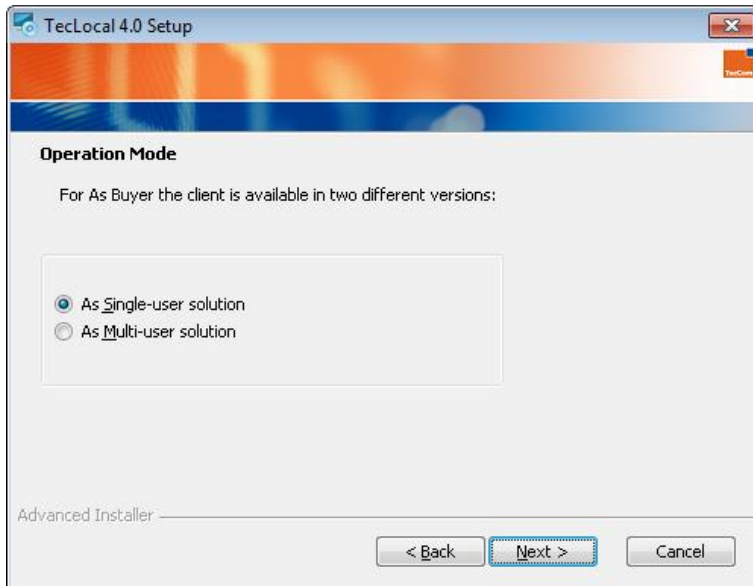

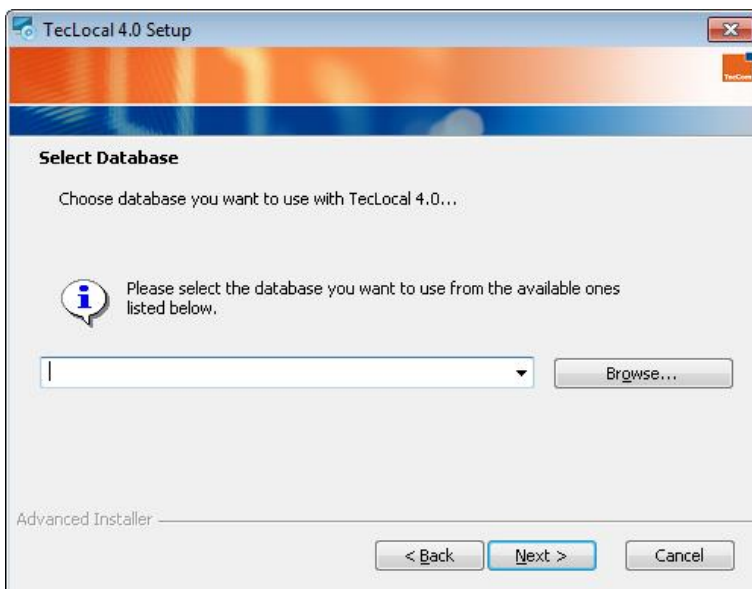
Select *"As Multi-user solution"*, then click *"Next"*



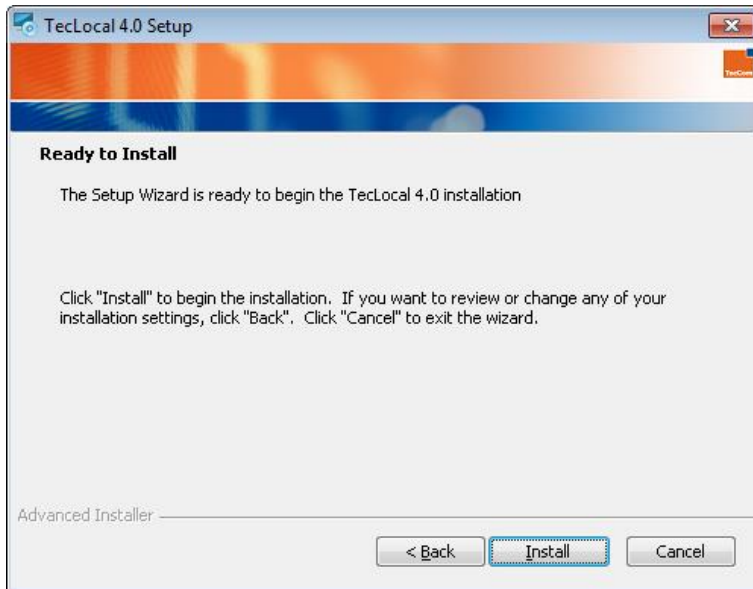
Read the End-User License Agreement, then select *"I accept the terms in the License Agreement"* and click *"Next"*



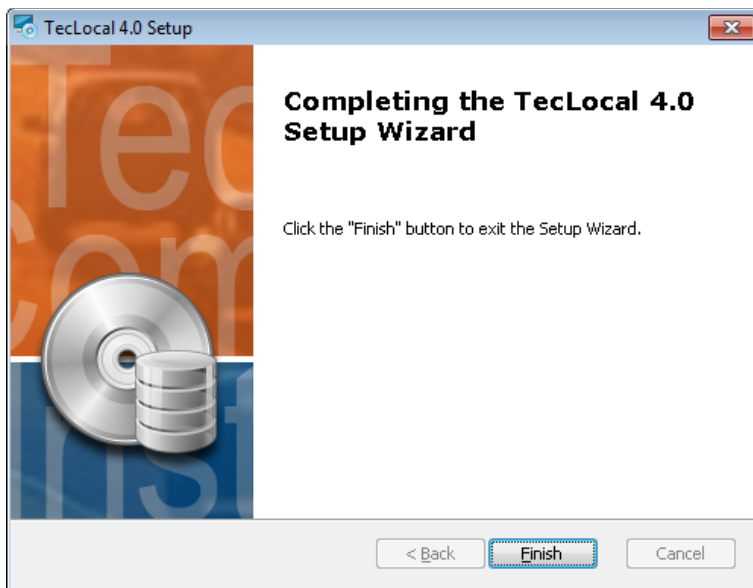
Type the SQL Server host or click “Browse” to search for the SQL Server hosts located in your network and then select the target SQL Server from the dropdown list. Then click “Next”

Click *"Finish"*

## 6 Import settings from previous version of TecLocal

If you have a previous compatible version of TecLocal installed, the installer will give you an option to import the existing settings.





Select whether you want to use existing settings or install the application from scratch.

## 6.1 Use existing settings

By using the existing settings you can import (take over) some installation parameters and thus reduce the number of installation dialogs. The settings that can be imported are:

- Operation mode
- Single/multiple user mode for buyer operation mode
- Copy over MS Access databases

Assumptions will be made based on the existing settings and if MS Access files are found in the database folder, they will be copied over to the new installation

## 6.2 Ask all options

By selecting all options, the installer will continue as if there was no previous version of TecLocal and thus can be configured from scratch. No Microsoft Access database will be copied over.

# 7 Installer options

There are few installer parameters that can be helpful when experiencing installation problems.

## 7.1 Logging of installation process

Complete log of the installation process can be created by using the following parameters after the setup executive name:



TecLocal.Setup.exe /lvx <logfile>

If the installer is started with these parameters an installation log file specified in the <logfile> parameter will be created.
