PERSONAL DATA

When you register for the conference, we will process your personal data.

Göteborg & Co AB is the controller for the processing of personal data.

Göteborg & Co is tasked with marketing Gothenburg and the Gothenburg region, as well as guiding how the destination is presented.

WHY DO WE PROCESS PERSONAL DATA

The data we process consists of images and videos. We process this data to provide information about our activities. The legal basis for the processing is the performance of a task carried out in the public interest, Article 6(1)(e) GDPR.

HOW DO WE USE PERSONAL DATA

We publish images and videos on our website and on our LinkedIn channels. We delete images and videos after five years.

To manage images and videos, we use a media bank, Mediaflow, provided by the data processor Mediaflow Europe AB.

YOUR RIGHTS

If you do not wish to appear in images or videos at all, please contact us before the FN Summit. You may request that we delete any image or video in which you appear. You can reach us using the contact details below.

According to the GDPR you have several rights that you should be aware of. The rights are described in Articles 15–21 of the GDPR.

RIGHT OF ACCESS

There is a right of access, which means that you can ask to get confirmation as to whether or not your personal data is being processed by Göteborg & Co. If your personal data is processed, you can also ask to get access to the data with information about the processing.

RECTIFICATION

There is a right to rectification, which means that you have the right to obtain, without undue delay, the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning yourself.

ERASURE

There is a right to erasure that means that we in some cases have to erase personal data about you.

RESTRICTION OF PROCESSING

In some cases there is a right to obtain restriction of processing, which means the marking of stored personal data with the aim of limiting the processing in the future.

COMPLAINTS

If you believe that we are in breach of the GDPR or other privacy legislation, you can file a complaint with the Swedish Authority for Privacy Protection.

DATA PROTECTION OFFICER

We have a Data Protection Officer seated at the Data Protection Unit within the City of Gothenburg.
