

Terms for granting and issuing press accreditations for Ultrace 2020

1. As part of the Ultrace 2020 event (called: "Event"), which will be held on 25-26 June 2020. At Stadion Wrocław, Aleja Śląska 1, 54-118 Wrocław, organized by Go Hard Sp. z o.o., with registered office at ul. R. Wojaczka 19/60, 51-169 Wrocław, KRS: 0000639506, NIP: 8992798990, REGON: 365509488 (called: the "Organizer"), free press accreditations are granted to journalists representing press publishers, Internet and TV publishers authorized to conduct activities in the field of mass communication media and for those not mentioned above, based on the decision issued by the Organizer.

2. At the Event, one type of accreditation is provided - MEDIA

3. Press accreditations authorize journalists to participate in all program events within the Event, excluding events covered by separate invitations

4. All accreditations are granted on the basis of completed registration forms located at <https://raceism.com/media/>, subject to the provisions of paragraph 6 below.

5. Registration for journalists takes place in two stages. After completing the registration form available at <https://raceism.com/media/>, the acceptance process takes place. If the application is successful, a confirmation will be sent to the e-mail address provided in the form.

6. The number of journalistic accreditations is limited.

7. The organizer reserves the right to refuse to grant accreditation at any stage of registration, without providing justification. To appeal, please send a message to: media@raceism.com.

8. The press accreditation issued may be picked up in person at the places indicated by the Organizer during the Event.

9. Accreditations are issued on the basis of a valid press card, a certificate of cooperation with the editors of the publisher referred to in paragraph 1 above and in other cases on the basis of the Organizer's decision.

10. During the performance of journalistic tasks, accreditation must be placed by its holder in a place visible to the event's security service.

11. Accreditation is personal and can not be transferred to another person.

12. The organizer does not recover the costs of accommodation and transport of journalistic accreditation holders.

13. The accredited person is obliged to send material from the event to 30 days after the event to the address media@raceism.com. It is possible to send in the form of a link to the coverage.
