



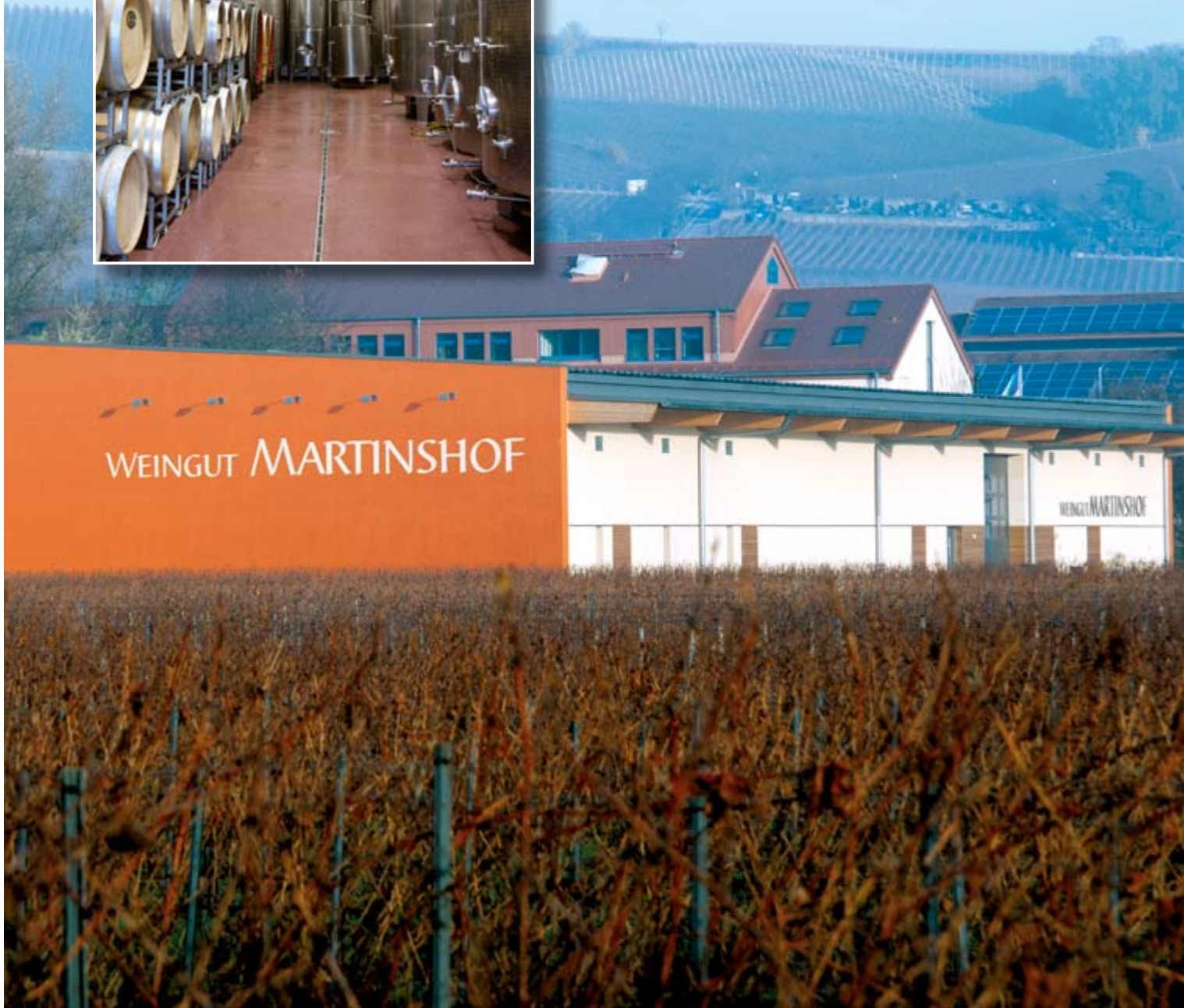

The Martinshof Winery in Dientheim on the River Rhine offers an excellent selection of fine wines, from light fruity whites to full-bodied reds. When constructing a brand new industrial building, this family firm opted for a solid foundation for the processing, bottling and storage of their wines: a floor coating with Silikal reactive resins.

The metal shelves with their heavy wooden barrels and the high stainless steel tanks weigh heavily on the red reactive resin floor in the storage area of the Martinshof Winery in Dientheim. The bright Silikal surface in the bottling and processing area has to withstand constant forklift traffic. There are puddles of spilled wine on the floors. The coating takes all this in its stride. The highly durable coatings are completely seamless, non-porous and resistant to fruit

acid, alkalis, oils and many other aggressive substances.

The approx. 900 m<sup>2</sup> area of the new working quarters at the "Martinshof" has been coated with a MMA (methyl methacrylate) system. An operation which, thanks to the rapid curing time of the resin (about an hour), can be done extremely quickly and so almost always without any major disruption to business operation. The broadcast of coloured quartz

gives the finished surface both excellent slip-resistance and an interesting, uniquely colourful look.

A particular advantage for the physiologically harmless Silikal floors in the wine industry is its low-maintenance. The sealed surface can be cleaned effectively without problems, and the triangle coving and coving also help to ensure the best possible hygiene.
