The Majors are the entry point of study for all Bachelor students from which they move towards the professional contexts of their choosing. The Autonomous, Social and Commercial Practices provide the interdisciplinary research contexts in the second half of the Bachelor programmes. They allow all students to create highly individual study paths that lead the students to the specific professional contexts the students seek out.

The Graduation Show is organised in three sections: the Autonomous, Commercial, or Social Practices that guided their professional education at the WdKA.
